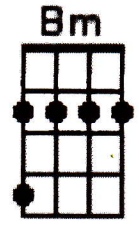
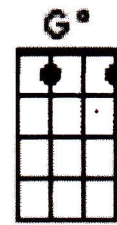
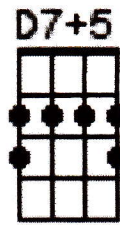


"It's Only A Paper Moon"
